Mark October 15 and 16, 2011, on your calendar as that is the weekend of the Llano County Heritage Festival, sponsored by Llano Main Street. We have held this festival since 1989 when Llano was placed in the National Register of Historic Places. The festival now is a two-day event, with activities planned for both days.

Please note the deadline for booth applications at the early bird fee of \$35 is September 30, 2011. Late entries, with a fee of \$50 per booth, will be accepted through October 11, 2011. This will give us time to make booth assignments and notify participants of their location ahead of time.

The week-end will be full of activities, with the Llano River Chuck Wagon Cook-off in Badu Park on the north side Llano River Bridge, a short walk to enjoy all activities.

In addition to vendors, there will be music both days, living history displays, and a historic photography show in the Llano Courthouse courtroom. The Badland Rangers will on the square, after a two year absence. The historic Red Top Jail will have jail tours all day, along with other activities. We are encouraging everyone to dress in period costume. Our music line up so far is Floyd Domino, J. Arthur Martinez and Manny Duarte. We are hoping to add to our living history demonstrations; if you know of anyone who would like to participate, please let me know.
